It is with great pleasure that we invite You to this year's symposium in Austria. This will take place from 28th May to 31st May 2025 in the Dorfgemeinschaften Wienerwald, Breitenfurt near Vienna, Austria.

The conference theme is: 'Music therapy in the field of neurology'.

During this conference we would like to broaden our view of some of the neurological diseases and consider what important role music therapy can play. These diseases are: Epilepsy, Multiple Sclerosis and Parkinson's Disease. Special consideration will be given to the neurological-sensory system, which is more in demand than ever in our world for its 'healthiness'.

We are pleased to welcome three doctors.

Mr Prim. Prof. Dr Gottfried Kranz He was a senior consultant in the neurology department at Vienna General Hospital and is currently medical director at the "Rosenhügel Neurological Rehabilitation Centre" in Vienna. Venus of his training has included the Filderklinik Stuttgart, the Lukasklinik Arlesheim and the Gemeinschaftskrankenhaus Havelhöhe-Berlin.

Hans C. Miersch M.A. is a doctor, systemic therapist and counsellor (SG), music therapist (Musiktherapeutische Arbeitsstätte) and anthroposophical art therapist (BVAKT). He has undergone further training in mediation, biography work and trauma therapy with EMDR. He works as a ward doctor (ward for people with epilepsy and intellectual disability) at the Tabor Epilepsy Clinic, Bernau near Berlin.

Dr. Susanne Wicht, specialist in neurology. She has been clinically active in neurology at the University Medical Centre and in acute psychiatry with a focus on geriatric psychiatry since 1995. She also works in inpatient and outpatient neurological rehabilitation in all rehabilitation phases. Training in anthroposophical medicine (GAÄD recognition and international diploma).

Mr Miersch and Dr Wicht will accompany our entire conference and take part in the working groups.

This year we would like to organise the **working groups** in such a way that each participant can report from his own experience. The working groups should offer space for the exchange of experiences and have a research character. We would like to work phenomenologically and penetrate and organise the conference topic in a music-therapeutic way.

Four groups with different focal points are currently planned.

Epilepsy
Multiple sclerosis (with a focus on the alphorn)
Parkinson's disease
Singing therapy in the neurological field
